We are passionate and tireless about educating our students!

In the first day packet, please fill out your forms and return by Sept. 8 between 1-5:00PM. For families who missed material pick up times, materials may be picked up and forms may be completed on site. This will be a drive through drop off. Masks and safe practices will be demonstrated, please.

Enclosed in the packet you will find:

2020-2021 Class Meeting Schedule, PTC, SSC, ELAC, whole Child Wellness, Principal Coffee Chats, Parent Support With Distance Learning. The zoom codes are established for the schoolwide meetings. Teachers will send out separate zoom codes for the class meetings. For Class meetings we expect to have 100% of our students supported by having a parent or guardian in attendance.

Voluntary Class Contributions- we are asking for a \$25.00 voluntary contribution for each student to support student supplies and needs for the fall of 2020-2021. We recognize the hardships COVID19 has caused our families. On Sept. 8, we can accept checks with your student's name and teacher name in the memo line, please. This is voluntary and allows basic skills to transform to excellence. We thank you!

PTC will have an annual membership drive and Make Mona Smile campaign. We will be greatly reducing all fundraising. In the First Day Packets are forms on how to support the many committees and services that PTC supports to enrich the lives of our students. Please join our insightful parent leaders and/or dedicated committees.

How to Update your information in Infinite Campus form is enclosed. This is a critical year when texting and emails will be utilized in our communication.

TDAP: all 7th graders must submit proof of TDAP prior to school beginning. Please send it to donna-roots@scusd.edu. This is required for enrollment and class attendance.

With practice and patience, you will learn how to access these platforms. Your child's teacher can support you. Attendance will be critical and we have a Leonardo da Vinci Response to Intervention Plan that includes: emailing, calling, and setting up attendance focus meetings for students who are consistently attending school. We are thankful to our parents for supporting attendance with routines for sleep, breakfast, incentivizing expected participation, and well-lit work stations so students are ready to learn.

Volunteers! We need our parent volunteers more than ever. The classroom teachers will be seeking parent class treasurers, class managers, zoom center helpers', etc. To volunteer you must have a TB test submitted to the main office and you must have cleared a background check (free- form enclosed).

Communication, feedback, and progress monitoring were the focus areas of our summer planning (based on our knowledge and parent feedback). Your child's teacher will send out a draft of the start of school schedule, weekly schedules, zoom codes for the fall, how parents get information about assignments on google classroom, feedback and progress monitoring. The schedule allows for small groups and some one on one interventions. Please be prepared to check google classroom daily and you will receive progress information, weekly.

Communication with teachers: please email your student's teacher directly if you have questions. Unprofessional group emails or emails disclosing personal information about one's own child to the parent group does not build a productive and caring class community. You can send communication around your work hours to the teacher but please give the teacher ample time to respond. Teachers cannot respond during evenings and weekends. Our teachers are known to go above and beyond.

We will send a weekly school letter from the school and Ms. Ballard, our Assistant Principal and our Leadership Team will send a weekly community building video message.

You can count on me. We can count on each other. That's our theme and song for 2020-2021. We are here from an academic and emotional realm for all our students and families. We can do this.



Before volunteering on campus you must have:

- > A current negative TB test result on file with the office
- > A current, cleared SCUSD Volunteer Sex Offender Check Authorization or
- > Fingerprints on file with SCUSD

TB Testing can be done through your doctor or various Medical Clinics (some Rite-Aid and CVS locations offer TB testing). A PPD (intradermal) tuberculin skin test or chest X-ray are the only acceptable methods permitted. The doctor's report must certify "freedom from active tuberculosis". TB tests are "good" (kept on file) for four years, chest X-rays for eight. All TB tests are a two-step process, administered one day and then read two days later. The district NO LONGER provides free TB screenings.

Sex Offender Background Checks must be done every school year. Turn your completed form into the School Community Liaison, or with your first day packet. There is no charge for Sex Offender Background Checks. SCUSD may soon be requiring every volunteer to be fingerprinted.

<u>If you have fingerprints on file with SCUSD</u> **you do not need to return this form**. If you have been an active fingerprinted volunteer in the district and are NEW to LdV, contact the SCL so that your clearances can be requested from your last volunteer school.

Fingerprinting* must be done at the Serna Center. Fingerprinting hours are Monday through Friday, 8 am – 11:30 & 1 - 5 pm. You must have a completed SCUSD Volunteer Fingerprinting/Background Check Authorization form with you. The charge for fingerprinting is \$47. Payment can be made with exact cash (no change is available), credit card, check or money order. Fingerprints are "good" for the duration of volunteering in the district. Call the Fingerprinting Office at 643-7449 with any questions.

What is the PTC?

Where does the PTC get those funds?

The Parent Teacher Council has 3 major fundraisers in which LdV families participate to raise the bulk of our yearly budget. We have a Fireworks booth in the summer, and in the fall a magazine fundraiser and an annual fund called Make Mona Smile. When well supported by the LdV community, we can raise around \$28,000. The rest of the funds come from small fundraisers throughout the year.

Meal Service Changes Starting September 3rd

Curbside meal services will resume when Sacramento City Unified School District (SCUSD) starts on September 3rd, with new federal requirements in place. Beginning September 3, 2020 SCUSD, Nutrition Services Department will offer curbside meal services at select school sites to SCUSD enrolled students, children enrolled in SCUSD Child Development Programs, or associated Charter School enrolled students only. Meals should be picked up at a student's school of enrollment. For students who attend a school that is not offering curbside meal service, meals may be picked up from the nearest school offering meals. Prior to September 3, 2020, families will receive an Enrollment Verification Letter to Obtain School Meals for each enrolled student; printed on gold paper in the mail. The Enrollment Verification Letter to Obtain School Meals will be required to be presented to Nutrition Services staff to receive school meals for each student, each day. A copy of this letter will also be emailed to the email address on file.

- Curbside meal services will start on Thursday, September 3, 2020 from 11:00am 12:30pm.
- Curbside meal services will continue to be offered every Monday, Wednesday and Friday from 11:00am –
 12:30pm during distance learning.
- The Enrollment Verification Letter to Obtain School Meals must be presented each day to obtain school meals.
- Meals will be provided for each enrolled student. Children not enrolled in school will not be eligible for meals.
- Meals should be picked up at a student's school of enrollment or school within the same region. If a family has
